Congratulations! Virginia State Team Wins First Place at the 2023 B.A.S.S. Southeastern Regional on Douglas Lake in Tennessee. Kevin Walton of Virginia Bassmasters led the team and taking first place for the tournament. He and Larry Witt will be competing at the B.A.S.S. National Championship in October on Lake Hartwell. Craig encouraged any input you can offer Kevin so Region 7 can have a National champion!!

New Business:

Craig reported major congestion experienced at the Waterlily Ramp in Coinjock, NC last weekend. Both Little Creek and Virginia Bassmasters showed up for club tournaments among many, many other boat owners using the ramp just boat riding or attending the boat fest going on in Currituck Sound on Saturday. Needless to say, trailers filled the parking lot and lined the road going to the ramp. Currently, NCWRC requires any club with 15 or less boats to obtain an L15 permit which permit is a banket permit and does not require naming the ramp or the date. The Game Warden showed up during Virginia Bassmasters' weighin and was not aware of any such blanket permit so Craig was given a ticket. Monday, Craig contacted the NCWRC and proved there is a blanket permit and that his was obtained in January this year. His ticket has been nullified. Nonetheless, the Game Warden is initiating changes in the way NCWRC provides permits and has requested Virginia clubs to join in the NC website that calendars tournament schedules. The goal is to have permits stating the body of water and the date to avoid more than one club tournament at a ramp. Of course, NC clubs will get first choice.
