OFF LIMITS:	Off Limits, within 50 yards of Marina Gas Pumps and any areas posted no fishing by state or other official authorities	
FLIGHT OUT:	Blast off from volunteer boat. Boats should be in the water by 5:30amVolunteers:5:30 am (sunrise 6:02am) OR First Safe Light – Return at 2:30pmField (1 flight):Follows Volunteer Flight – Return at 3:00 pmIf 2 flights:Follows first flight – Return at 3:15 pmCheck in at flag near ramp dock	
CREEL:	5 Fish (14" minimum)	
SCALES OPEN:	3:00 pm or when directed by Tournament Director Trailer your boat prior to weigh-in.	
NOTE:	Times may be adjusted due to weather conditions as determined by the Tournament Director.

- NO ALABAMA RIGS ALLOWED.
- Running lights on, life jackets secure, and kill switch hooked up during flight out.
- Life jackets on and secure at all times main engine is in gear.
- ADHERE TO ALL NO WAKE ZONES.
- Weigh in bags will be available if needed. Please use your own bag to bring fish to scales.
- Announce your boat number as you approach the scales and be sure to sign your weigh in slip. Once you turn over your fish, you will not be able to handle them again until after they have been weighed. There will be no "courtesy measures" allowed.
- Standings will not be discussed during the weigh in process.
